Scratch was developed with funding from the National Science Foundation. It is a free (and addictively engaging) computer programming language for children. Scratch is also used in introductory computer science courses at Harvard and Berkeley. As students create Scratch projects, they develop their drawing, logic, programming, and creative-thinking skills – and they grow as artists and engineers.
